“Feeding wildlife is not in the best interest of wildlife as it often leads to property damage and/or safety issues for people and pets living in the area. The majority of wildlife attacks in Arizona are the result of fed wildlife becoming habituated to humans. Feeding, attracting, or enticing wildlife (except birds and tree squirrels) is illegal in Pima, Pinal and Maricopa counties. Violations can result in up to a \$300 fine.”

Don't forget the good eats at the **Diamond Desert Casino** (520) 547-4321, like pizza, sandwiches and salads! It's why we love Why!

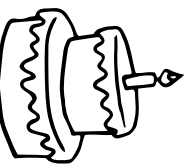
